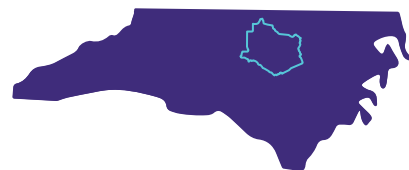

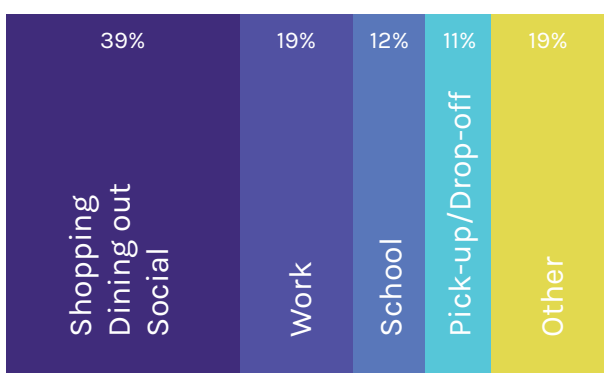
To help state and regional transportation agencies in the Triangle better plan and prioritize improvements to our transportation system

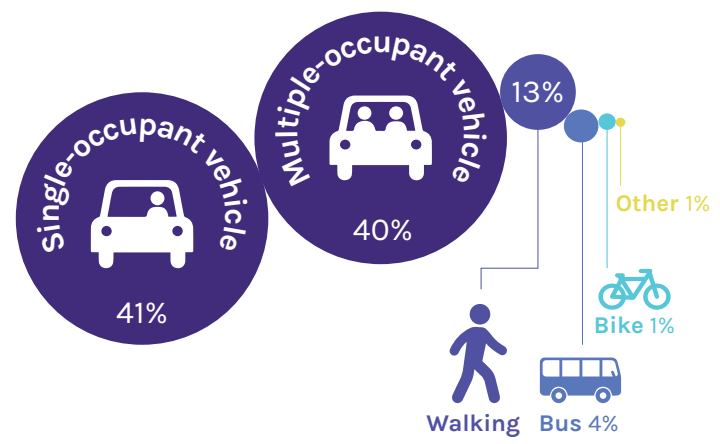

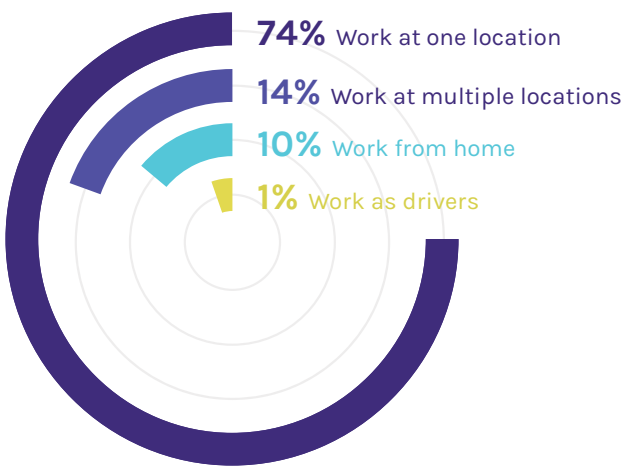

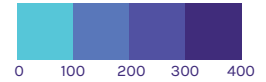


Daily Travel Patterns

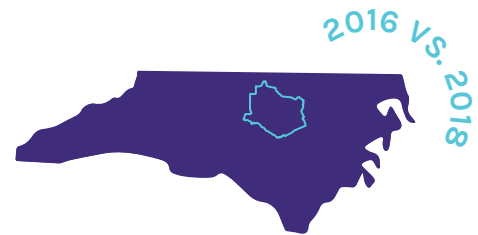
The travel patterns by time of day reflect the diversity of travel in the Triangle region with heavy travel activity throughout the day, and not just during peak periods.
